

Of Yahusha Ha`Mashiach

REVELATION

The Revelation of **Yahusha Ha`Mashiach**, which **El`ayim** gave to him, to show to his servants the things $\aleph$ which must shortly come to pass; and which he sent and signified by his messenger to his servant Yochanon: **2** Who gave an account of the Word of **El`ayim**, and of the testimony of **Yahusha Ha`Mashiach**, and of all things that he saw.

3 Greatly blessed are those who reads and who hear the words of this prophecy, and guard those things which are written, for the time approaches.

4 Yochanon to the seven congregations which are in Asia: Grace to you, and peace, from him which is, and which was, and which is to come; and from the seven **Breaths** which are before his throne; **5** And from **Yahusha Ha`Mashiach**, the faithful witness, the firstborn of the dead, and the Prince of the kings of the earth. to him who loved us and washed us from our sins in his own blood, **6** And has made us kings and priests to **El`ayim** and his Father; to him is glory and dominion forever and ever. So it is.⁸⁸⁹ **7** Behold, he comes with clouds;⁸⁹⁰ and every eye shall see him;⁸⁹¹ and those who pierced him⁸⁹² and all kindreds of the earth shall wail because of him. Even so: So it is. **8** I am the $\aleph$ (Aleph) and the τ (Tav), the beginning and the ending, says **Yahuah El`ayim**, which is, and which was, and which is to come, **Yahuah Tseva`oth**.⁸⁹³

9 I Yochanon, who also is your brother, and companion in tribulation, and in the Kingdom and patience of **Yahusha Ha`Mashiach**, was in the isle that is called Patmos, for the Word of **El`ayim**, and for the testimony of **Yahusha Ha`Mashiach**. **10** I was in the **Breath** on the day of **Yahuah**, and heard behind me a great voice, as of a shofar, **11** Saying, I am the $\aleph$ (Aleph) and the τ (Tav),

and: What you see, write in a cephher, and send it to the seven congregations which are in Asia; to Ephesus, and to Smyrna, and to Pergamos, and to Thyatiera, and to Sardis, and to Philadelphia, and to Laodikeia. **12** And I turned to see the voice that spoke with me. And being turned, I saw seven golden menorahs;^{895, 896} **13** And in the middle of the seven menorahs was one the similitude of **Ben A`dam**, clothed with a garment down to the foot, and girded about the chest with a golden belt. **14** His head and hair were white like wool,⁸⁹⁷ as white as snow; and his eyes were like a flame of fire; **15** And his feet were like fine brass,⁸⁹⁸ as if they burned in a furnace; and his voice like the sound of many waters.⁸⁹⁹ **16** And he had in his right hand seven stars: and out of his mouth went a sharp two-edged sword:⁹⁰⁰ and his countenance was as the sun shining in its strength. **17** And when I saw him, I fell at his feet as dead. And he laid his right hand upon me, saying to me, Fear not:

I am the first and the last.⁹⁰¹

18 And the living and rendered dead; and behold, I am alive forevermore: So be it; and have the keys of She`ol and of death. **19** Write the things $\aleph$ which you have seen, and the things which are, and the things which shall be hereafter; **20** The mystery of the seven stars which you saw in my right hand, and the seven golden menorahs. The seven stars are the messengers of the seven congregations: and the seven menorahs which you saw are the seven congregations.

2 Unto the messenger of the congregation of Ephesus write; These things says he who holds the seven stars in his right hand, who walks in among the seven golden

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menorahs;⁹⁰² **2** I know your works, and your labor, and your patience, and how you cannot bear them which are evil: and you have tried them which say they are apostles, and are not, and have found them liars: **3** And have borne, and have patience, and for my name's sake have labored, and have not fainted. **4** There are other things that hold you down, because you have left your first love. **5** Remember therefore from where you have fallen, and repent, and do the first works; or else I will come to you quickly and remove your menorah⁹⁰³ out of his place, except that you repent. **6** But this you have: you hate the deeds of the Niyqolaciym, which I also hate. **7** He that has an ear, let him hear $\aleph$ what the **Breath** says to the congregations; To him that overcomes will I give to eat of the tree of life,⁹⁰⁴ which is in middle the paradise of **El'ayim**.

8 And to the messenger of the congregation in Smyrna write: These things say the first and the last, which was dead, and is alive: **9** I know your works, and tribulation, and poverty, (but you are rich) and the blasphemy of those who say they are Yahudiym, and are not, but are the synagogue of Satan. **10** Fear none of those things which you shall suffer: behold, Diabolos shall cast you into prison, that you may be tried; and you shall have tribulation for ten days: be faithful to death, and I will give you a crown of life. **11** He that has an ear, let him hear $\aleph$ what the **Breath** says to the congregations; He that overcomes shall not be hurt by the second death.

12 And to the messenger of the congregation in Pergamos write; These things he says who has the sharp sword with two edges: **13** I know your works, and where you dwell, where Satan's seat is: and you hold fast my name, and have not denied my faith, even in those days in which Antipas, my faithful martyr, was slain among you, where Satan dwells. **14** But I have a few things against you, because you have those who hold the doctrine of Bil'am, who taught Balaq to cast a stumbling block before the children of Yashar'el, to eat things sacrificed to idols, and to commit fornication.⁹⁰⁵ **15** So have you also those who hold

the doctrine of the Niyqolaciym, which thing I hate. **16** Repent; or else I will come to you quickly and will fight against them with the sword of my mouth. **17** He who has an ear, let him hear $\aleph$ what the **Breath** says to the congregations; To him that overcomes will I give the hidden manna to eat, and will give him a white stone, and in the stone a new name written, which no man knows save him who receives it.

18 And to the messenger of the congregation in Thyatiera write; These things say the **Ben El'ayim**, who has his eyes like a flame of fire, and his feet *are* like fine brass; **19** I know your works: love, service, faith, and your patience, and your works; and the last more than the first. **20** Notwithstanding I have a few things against you, because you suffer that woman Iyzebel, who calls herself a prophetess to teach and to seduce my servants to commit fornication, and to eat things sacrificed to idols.⁹⁰⁶ **21** And I gave her space to repent of her fornication; and she did not repent. **22** Behold, I will cast her and those who commit fornication with her onto a sick-bed and into great tribulation, unless they repent of their deeds. **23** And I will kill her children with death; and all the congregations shall know that I am he who searches the minds and hearts: and I will give to every one of you according to your works.⁹⁰⁷ **24** But to you I say, and to the rest in Thyatiera, as many as do not have this doctrine, and who have not known the depths of Satan, as they speak; I will put upon you no other burden. **25** But that which you have, hold fast till I come. **26** And he, who overcomes, and guards my works to the end, to him will I give power over the nations: **27** And he shall rule them with a rod of iron; as the vessels of a potter shall they be broken to shivers:⁹⁰⁸ even as I received of my Father. **28** And I will give him the morning star. **29** He that has an ear, let him hear $\aleph$ what the **Breath** says to the congregations.

3 And to the messenger of the congregation in Sardis write: These things says he who has the seven **Breaths of El'ayim**, and the seven stars: I know your works, that you
